# Intentionally Practical

## No Sweat Evangelism Small Group Lesson 2

### Listening Guide

#### LESSON OBJECTIVE:

To embrace the importance of \_\_\_\_\_ Jesus intentionally by \_\_\_\_\_ our faith and to learn practical ways we can begin to do this.

#### Matthew 4:19

Jesus said, “\_\_\_\_\_ me and I will make you fishers of men.”

Use the 4 W's to become \_\_\_\_\_ in sharing your faith.

#### 1. WHO

Have you identified your “\_\_\_\_\_”?

- Name someone related to you \_\_\_\_\_ is not a Christian.
- Name someone that lives near you \_\_\_\_\_ is not a Christian.
- Name someone that you work with or go to school with \_\_\_\_\_ is not a Christian.
- Name someone you have encountered in your weekly schedule \_\_\_\_\_ is not a Christian.
- Name someone you are connected with on \_\_\_\_\_ media \_\_\_\_\_ is not a Christian.

Bottom Line: Find out where \_\_\_\_\_ are and start getting around them.

#### 2. WHAT

What am I going to do to \_\_\_\_\_ this person?

- \_\_\_\_\_ for them.
- Have \_\_\_\_\_ or coffee with the person.
- Volunteer to \_\_\_\_\_ the person coach.
- Volunteer to join the person in a \_\_\_\_\_ or job.
- \_\_\_\_\_ the family over for a meal.

The goal in answering the “\_\_\_\_\_” question is to establish an environment in which you can get to know the person and have a gospel conversation with them.

### 3. WHEN

The “when” question is all about scheduling a \_\_\_\_\_ date and time.

If you don’t put a time stamp on “\_\_\_\_\_” you want your “\_\_\_\_\_” to happen with your “\_\_\_\_\_,” then it just remains a good idea floating around in your head. Put it on your calendar. Set it as an appointment.

### 4. WHERE

This question is all about \_\_\_\_\_. Where will your “what” take place with your “who”? The goal is to be specific as possible. The more \_\_\_\_\_ you are, the more apt you are to follow through.

#### LESSON OBJECTIVE:

To share the urgency of making \_\_\_\_\_ when you share the gospel with someone and train us in helping others to cross the line of faith.

Today we want to learn about the importance and urgency of \_\_\_\_\_.

#### Scripture:

- Romans 10:9
- Romans 10:13

#### Application:
